## INSTITUTIONAL POLICY

Last Revised and Approved: 04.17.2014

### Purpose:

This policy provides guidance on the use of institutional funds for travel.

### Scope:

This policy applies to all employees, faculty, and students of the University.

### Definitions:

Employee: Any person who is employed by the University, including full-time, part-time, and temporary employees.

Faculty: Any person who is appointed to teach courses at the University, including full-time, part-time, and temporary faculty members.

Student: Any person who is enrolled in a degree program at the University, including full-time, part-time, and temporary students.

Travel: Any trip made by an employee, faculty, or student for the purpose of conducting University business.

Business Travel: Any trip made by an employee, faculty, or student for the purpose of conducting University business.

Personal Travel: Any trip made by an employee, faculty, or student for personal reasons.

Reimbursement: Any payment made by the University to an employee, faculty, or student for expenses incurred during travel.

Expense Report: A document used to itemize and request reimbursement for expenses incurred during travel.

Travel Policy: This document, which outlines the rules and regulations for travel.

Travel Request Form: A form used to submit travel requests to the appropriate department or office.

Travel Approval: The process of obtaining permission to travel from the appropriate department or office.

Travel Itinerary: A document that details the travel plans, including destination, dates, and mode of transportation.

Travel Expenses: The costs associated with travel, such as airfare, lodging, meals, and transportation.

Travel Reimbursement: The amount of money paid by the University to an employee, faculty, or student for expenses incurred during travel.

Travel Policy: This document, which outlines the rules and regulations for travel.

**Requirements:** A root node is a node whose children are all leaf nodes.

• **Root**

• **Path**: A sequence of nodes connected by edges.

• **Level**: The depth of a node in a tree.

• **Height**: The height of a tree is the maximum level of any node in the tree.

• **Diameter**: The diameter of a tree is the maximum distance between any two nodes in the tree.

• **Subtree**: A subtree of a tree is a tree consisting of a node and all its descendants.

• **Parent**: A parent of a node is the node from which it descends.

• **Child**: A child of a node is a node that descends from it.

• **Sibling**: Siblings are nodes that have the same parent.

• **Ancestor**: An ancestor of a node is any node that lies on the path from the root to the node.

• **Descendant**: A descendant of a node is any node that lies on the path from the node to the root.

• **Level Order Traversal**: A traversal of a tree where nodes are visited level by level.

• **Inorder Traversal**: A traversal of a tree where nodes are visited in left-right-root order.

• **Postorder Traversal**: A traversal of a tree where nodes are visited in left-right-root order.

• **Preorder Traversal**: A traversal of a tree where nodes are visited in root-left-right order.

• **Depth-First Search (DFS)**: A search algorithm that explores as far as possible along each branch before backtracking.

• **Breadth-First Search (BFS)**: A search algorithm that explores all the neighbors of a node before moving to the next level of nodes.

• **Binary Tree**: A tree where each node has at most two children.

• **Full Binary Tree**: A binary tree where every node has either zero or two children.

• **Complete Binary Tree**: A binary tree where every level is completely filled except possibly the last level, which is filled from left to right.

• **AVL Tree**: A self-balancing binary search tree where the height of the left and right subtrees of any node differ by at most one.

• **BST**: A binary search tree where the left child of a node is less than the node and the right child is greater than the node.

• **Red-Black Tree**: A self-balancing binary search tree where every node is either red or black, and satisfies certain properties related to balance and color.

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
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
