DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #262 including 33A, 135A and 167A, totaling \$106,661.08; fund transfers covered by vouchers #263 through #269 amounted to \$52,312.17.

August payrolls were: Regular \$195, 523.19; Work Study \$15, 227.46.

A MOTION by Mr. Evans, seconded by Dr. Lehrman, approved the disbursements, and the transfer of funds and acknowledged the August payrolls. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PERSONNEL: Employment of Ronald Spann, Kara Knodel, and John Watland was approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

EXPOSITION CENTER: Change Order #2, with alternative A & B had been signed by Dr. Taylor. The change order cost \$34,034.50.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Nine scholarships totaling \$400 and one loan for \$200 were approved on MOTION by Dr. Lehrman, seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Taylor reported that considerable time had been spent preparing the budget for FY 77. It has now been submitted to the State Department of Higher Education. The
