

Seconded by Mr. Coleman. Affirmative vote unanimous.







Resolution to Establish CSI Aggies' Fund

Whereas the Board of Trustees has approved the hiring of an instructor

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Southern Idaho Junior College District, that:

(a) A new bank account be set up in the Idaho Bank & Trust in Twin Falls Idaho, the name of the account to be "CSI Aggies."

(b) The authorized signatures for said account be those of the Business manager of the College of Southern Idaho or the Assistant Business Manager, and that the single signature of either be valid on checks drawn on said account.

(d) Expenses for the above-mentioned activities be paid from said account.

(e) Authorization for expenditure of funds from said account shall be vested in the CSI Vocational Director evidenced by properly completed vouchers, signed by said Director.


(f) Authorization for said account and other provisions of this resolution be retroactive to March 25, 1977.
