Dear President Meyerhoeffer:

As you know, we have been working on the problem with the geothermal wells on campus for the past several months. The problem is now becoming acute in that we are experiencing a steady drop in pressure of some 1/2 pound per month.

Nelson, Rosholt, Robertson, Tolman & Tucker. Mr. Rosholt is the water lawyer in Idaho in my opinion. We also retained the services of Anderson & Kelly in Boise. That firm specializes in water and geology as that science is included in water problems.

The future holds for the District the possibility of heating and cooling all of our buildings with water from the wells. That project includes the rather expensive process of retro-fitting the buildings to accommodate that type of energy.

It is my opinion that the Board of Trustees has a duty to establish and protect this valuable asset which belongs

or our right in the geothermal resource before we go any further with implementing its use.

It is my recommendation that the Board of Trustees retain Mr. John Rosholt to pursue that objective. Mr. Rosholt has my highest recommendation and will be of immeasureable assistance to the Board.
