This early requirement is a change from previous years and is outlined in Idaho Code section 33-502. I.C. 502B provides that if the Trustee positions are not contested, an election need not be held.

There is a provision for write in candidates to file up to as late as 5 days prior to the election. This means that we will have to make all of the preparations for the election regardless of the provisions to be November 20th
