

PURCHASING PREFERENCE

(Policy Range: 30%

5020.00 Purchasing Preferences.

The Board of Trustees finds that Moscow School District to promote the patrons to support education. The Board of district funds tends to enhance the district and local community, thereby supporting property in the district and the will of residents to pay school taxes.

In awarding bids for the purchase of equipment or construction of public works, a preference to vendors domiciled in the district is required by Sections 67-2348 and 67-2349 of the applicable laws.

In purchasing any goods or services (other than by other procedure) the district may give a preference according to the following schedule, which is hereby granted pursuant to the preceding paragraphs.

<u>Amount of Bid</u>	<u>Preference</u>
\$ 0 - \$ 25,000	2% of bid
\$ 25,001 - \$ 50,000	\$ 500
\$ 50,001 - \$100,000	\$ 750
\$100,001 and up	\$1,000

The preference of local vendors shall be the amount computed in accordance with the above schedule. The preference of nonlocal vendor to arrive at an adjusted bid.
