
TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer's Report was approved on MOTION by Bill Babcock. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

Funding for this purchase is from various departmental budgets.

3. The Board approved the sole bid of Telecom Brokers of Denton, Texas in the amount of \$87,850.00 for the specified analog to digital conversion equipment on MOTION by Dr. Thad Scholes. Affirmative vote was unanimous.

Funding for this equipment is partially from the Technology department budget and partially from the Technology Construction department in the Plant Facility Fund.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

- 1. The Board authorized the administration to continue to spend funds in July and August of 2001 until we set our budget for Fy 2002 on August 20, 2001 on MOTION by Bill Babcock. Affirmative vote was unanimous.
- 2. Randy Dill reviewed the schedule of major campus maintenance projects for the summer. He also advised the Board that we were working on completing Division of Public Works projects that include crack seal and seal coating campus parking lots, renovating Frontier Road, sidewalk construction and repairing the fire lane access road to the gym.

The President noted that we are staying away from major projects in order to fund a portion of the new student union.


