

Re: Proposed Fiscal Year 2008 Tuition and Fee Increases

In putting together the budget for fiscal year 2008, it appears that we will need to increase tuition and fees again this year. We are recommending that an increase of \$5.00.

per credit or \$50 per full time student be implemented in the Fall of 2007.

The increase will consist of \$35 for Tuition, \$5 for the Registration Services Fee and \$10 for the Athletic Fee. The Athletic fee increase will be to assist in funding the Women's Softball and the cheerleading programs. Cheerleading is being moved from Student Association to Athletics but the funding for Student Association will not be reduced. The total of these increases is \$50.


The increase in the Tuition account and the Registration Services Fee totaling \$40 will raise approximately \$280,000 which will allow us to continue to properly staff our instructional and support service areas. With this increase, 78.10% of the total tuition and fees charged will go directly to the General Fund.

The \$50 increase equates to a 5.00% increase over last year. Foreign and Out of State fees will increase from \$2,800 to \$2,950 which is a 5.36% increase. Dual credit fees are set at \$65 in conjunction with a statewide proposal by the Idaho State Board of Education. The dual credit per credit cost will increase will increase from \$60 to \$65 which is an increase of 8.33%.

This request has been reviewed by and is supported by the administration and the College of Southern Idaho Student Senate. We respectfully request the Board approve the proposed Tuition and Fee increases for fiscal year 2008.





and a self audit annually? Additionally, once every three years, the Federal Government sends a review team to each Head Start program to ascertain whether the program is currently meeting all performance standards and abiding by the Head Start Act. South Central Head Start will be reviewed by the Federal team in the Fall of 2007. The self audit is important in helping the program prepare for the Federal review and, along with the community assessment, aids in planning for the upcoming program year.

The complete self audit of the program encompasses the administrative office and ten centers over 17,000 square miles throughout Southern Idaho, and traditionally involves a team of ten to fifteen
