_____ I understand that an F or a W on my transcript will negatively impact my ability to receive financial aid in the future, even if these grades were earned in a dual credit course.

_____ I understand that college classes often have attendance requirements and failure to meet those requirements may result in a failed grade.

____ I understand that I will be held to the same academic and behavioral standards as a full-time CSI student including standards outlined in the student handbook.
