GUIDPDACEMENT:

All students enrolling in rst-year writing courses at the College of Southern Idaho must complete THE WRITE CLASS prior to registering for writing classes. Without a WRITE Cl score on record, you will be enrolled in ENGL 101+*. Log in to csi.thewriteclass.org with your CSI network username and password to complete THE WRITE CLASS survey.



THE WRITE CLASS is not a test. It is a survey that gathers information from you about high school GPA (if available), any recent standardized test scores**, and previous reading and writing experiences. In addition to a placement recommendation, THE WRITE CLASS gives you knowledge of course expectations for each of the writing courses CSI o ers. You will also see sample assignments. Having this knowledge will help you succeed.

The recommendation you receive from THE WRITE CLASS (plus standardized test scores** if you have them) provide excellent guidance as to which course will allow you to be most successful as you begin your rst-year writing coursework.

If you place above both ENGL 101 and ENGL 102 you may enroll in ENGL 201 as a substitute for ENGL 101 and pay transcription fee for ENGL 102 after successful completion of ENGL 201 (Applies only to AA, AS, & AE degrees).
