- 1. The clinical phase of instruction will be educational, focusing on clinical competencies for surgical area.
- 2. When a student demonstrates proficiency, the student may be permitted to function alone with appropriate supervision and direction (preceptor available, and in the room). This will be monitored by the coordinator of the Surgical Technology Program when visiting or calling the clinical facility and in reviewing the student's aliant evaluations.
