RESOLUTION # 4

TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO REGARDING PER DIEM FOR STUDENT TRAVEL

WHEREAS, the current policy allows \$20 per day for students and \$30 per day for employees, and

WHEREAS, the cost of meals generally does not differ for students versus employees, and

WHEREAS, the per diem amounts have not changed for many years even though food prices have risen dramatically, and

WHEREAS, the student per diem of \$20 is insufficient in nearly all locations to realistically cover the cost of student meals, and

WHEREAS, student clubs and organizations are primarily funded by student fees and fundraising with the support of institutional resources,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASCSI SENATE, ACTING AS REPRESENTATIVES OF CURRENT STUDENTS OF THE COLLEGE OF SOUTHERN IDAHO, THAT WE RECOMMEND TO THE ADMINISTRATION TO APPROVE THE INCREASE OF PER DIEM FOR STUDENTS TO AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THAT FOR EMPLOYEES.
